

Peripheral Vascular System - Denies intermittent claudication, coldness or trophic changes, varicose veins, peripheral edema or color change.

Hematologic System - Admits to anemia and easy bruising or bleeding. Denies lymph node enlargement or history of DVT/PE.

Endocrine System - Admits to heat or cold intolerance. Denies polyuria, polydipsia, polyphagia, goiter and hirsutism.

Nervous System - Admits to constant numbness in left leg. Denies seizures, loss of consciousness, sensory disturbances, paresthesia, dysesthesia, and hyperesthesia, ataxia, loss of strength, changes in cognition/mental status/memory or weakness.

Psychiatric - Denies depression/sadness, anxiety, obsessive/compulsive disorder and ever having seen a mental health professional.

Physical Examination

General: Average-sized female, well groomed, looks her stated age of 60 years

Weight 135 lbs. Height 62.4 inches BMI 24.7

Skin: warm and moist and smooth, good turgor. Nonicteric, no scars or tattoos. Two lesions found: 1) scaling from a dried pimple on left lower arm with slight scarring 2) mole - upper right arm - symmetrical circle, clear/sharp borders, uniform dark color, diameter < 6mm, slightly elevated.

Hair: ongoing loss of hair distribution - less than average quantity and distribution with some bald spots, texture unremarkable

Nails: no clubbing, capillary refill < 2 seconds throughout

Head: normocephalic, atraumatic, non-tender to palpation throughout.
